






Access Guide – EMIS Web GP Practices and Hubs

The Care and Health Information Exchange (CHIE) is a computer system used by the NHS and Social Care to safely share important information about a patient with those treating them.


You can use CHIE to access GP records, Community, and hospital records (pathology reports, X-ray or scan reports, discharge summaries and clinic letters) for patients registered to GPs in Hampshire and the Isle of Wight.

Accessing CHIE via EMIS Web

In EMIS Web, search and load a patient record as normal.




 From a screen in the care record (Summary in this example), expand the 'View My Record' section.



- Expand the Summary view to display the 'External Views' Windowlet.
- In the External Views windowlet, click on CHIE to launch the portal.
- Each user will be prompted to accept a disclaimer the first time that they carry out this process.

The Landing Page / Home Screen

 This is the first page that you will see, the content of which is determined by your job role (Role Based Access Level). An example of a typical Clinical Practitioner Landing Page:
